He is a titular member of the C.M.I., and served as one of the Advisors to the American Law Institute in connection with Restatement, Third, Agency. He is standing consultant on English law to Ang & Partners (Singapore) and undertakes international and domestic advisory work, including expert evidence, in the areas covered by his books, including conflict of laws aspects.
